Home and Community Based Services

Children's Waiver Goals

- Assists children and families in least restrictive environment possible.
- Provides culturally appropriate services based on the strengths, preferences, needs, and desired outcome of each child.
- Provides supports to participants at home and in the community.
- Serves children who would otherwise require care in environments such as long-term care facility or psychiatric in-patient care.

Personalized services evolve over time to meet the physical, developmental, and behavioral health needs of each child.

Target Population Criteria

Serious Emotional Disturbance (SED)

- *Experienced functional limitations due to emotional disturbance over the past 12 mos*
- *Designated mental illness diagnosis according to the most current edition of the DSM.*

Medically Fragile (MedF)

- *Children ages 0-21.*
- *Must have a physically documented disability.*
- *Chronic debilitating condition(s).*
- *May or may not be institutionalized or hospitalized.*

Must also meet one of these:

- *Technologically dependent.*
- *Complex medical intervention or medication regimen.*
- *Needing ongoing assessment and intervention.*

Process of Determination

Participants seeking HCBS with income above Medicaid eligibility allowances can still qualify for services via a needs-based Medicaid eligibility determination.

Our team can facilitate the application process for families in need of services.

We work with the family to ensure that they are supported through the application process and on through the delivery of services.

Caregiver or Family Supports and Services

The Goal

Acquisition

Services that help participants gain independence.

They obtain independency by learning how to do the task themselves.

The expectation of skill development needs to be something they can do within the authorized time period.

Maintenance

Services that stop or slows down the child's regression of skill.

Enhancement

These are activities that are given to the participants to build on the skills that they already have through training & demonstration.

Support the skills that they learned in an environment other than their usual learning space.
